Course Evaluation

With great success was completed the International Digital Course on Geoparks, with 110 participants from 44 countries, on the theme of “UNESCO Global Geoparks and Geotourism” that was held from 15 -25 November through a digital platform.

At the end of the course all the participants expressed enthusiasm for the experience of participating in the School of Geoparks, which was reflected in the evaluation process as they described it as the best training seminar for Geoparks to date.

The International Digital Course on Geoparks is co-organized annually by the University of the Aegean, the Natural History Museum of the Lesvos Petrified Forest, UNESCO and the Global Geoparks Network. It attracts world-wide interest and at the same time promotes Lesvos Island UNESCO Global Geopark as a training center and a model for the creation and operation of Geoparks around the world. It takes place in Lesvos every year, but for the past 3 years, due to the Covid-19 restrictions, it was held online under the coordination of the Natural History Museum of the Lesvos Petrified Forest.
